### The carvers like to come to Marion's

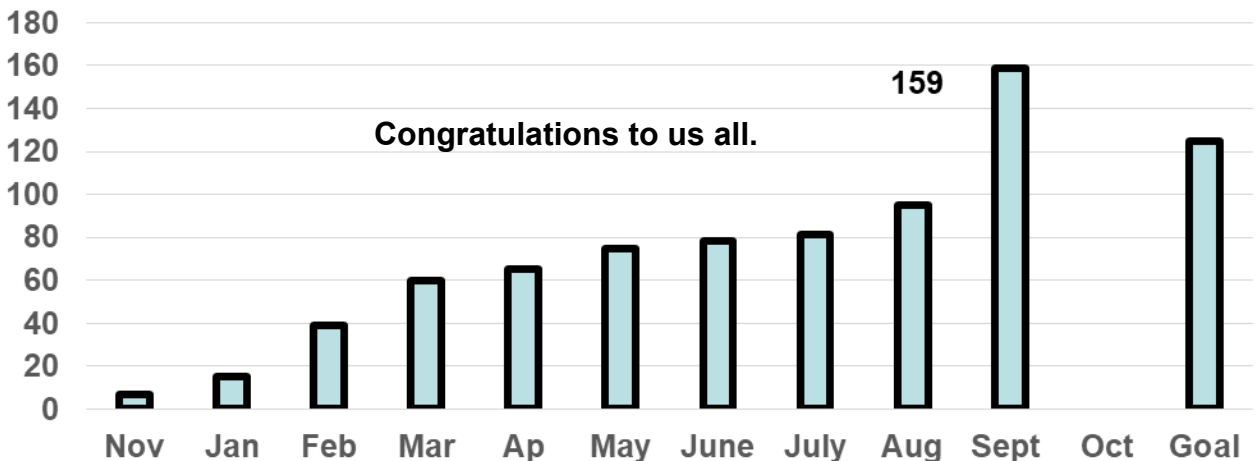
