It was, guess who, Tina Hammond, now \$12 richer.

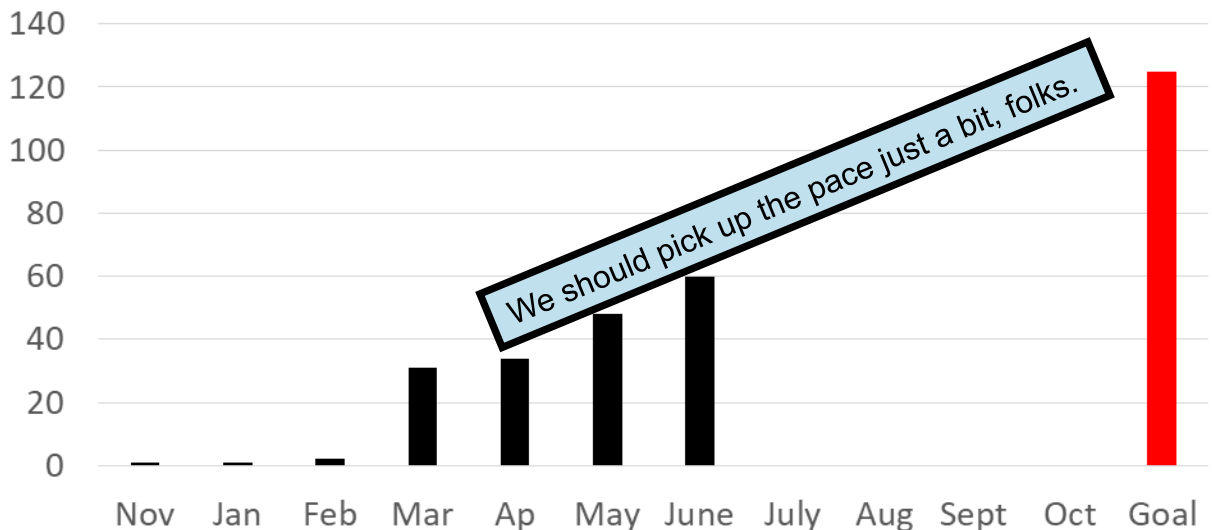
June Show & Tell Winner
